Advance Warning...No Hoodies

A reminder that with effect from January 2025, hoodies/hooded tops as an alternative to a coat, will no longer be permitted at school. However, with immediate affect, if your child is currently wearing a hoody/hooded top/ tracksuit top to school until a suitable coat can be purchased, it should be removed before they enter the school building. These are not part of the school uniform and should not be worn indoors.
