Unit Name and Number	Content.	Transition work
319 – Music Artist and the Media	A Multi-media presentation which analyses the relationship between the press and the artist. The choice of artist is your choice.	Read as much as possible about music artists working the world today. I would suggest reading a wide range of publications including the music press specifically.
349 – Planning a career in Music	This Unit gets to think really clearly about what jobs and careers are available to you after your studies.	It is never to early to think about the future. Research what is out there for you including University Courses. A really good place to start is the UCAS website.
365 – Auditioning for Music	This Unit is a chance for you to take part in a realistic rehearsal situation to take part in one of our showcase events. You will need to choose what you and how you want to present.	You will need to be a competent musician (*) so you need to keep practicing your skills
375 – Creating a Podcast	You will create a 20 minute podcast which you will create, record and edit. This must have a musical theme. In the past students have created podcasts on Taylor Swift, Anime, Film music. The options are endless.	The best preparation is too listen to as many podcasts as possible!! They don't have to be about music. It can be about food, sport, films. You will learn different styles of presenting
387- Music Skills – Rehearsal and Performance	This is an externally assessed Unit where you pick 20 minutes worth of repertoire. You then rehearse it and then perform it for assessment.	You will need to be a competent musician (*) so you need to keep practicing your skills
